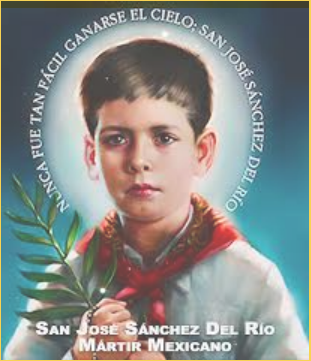

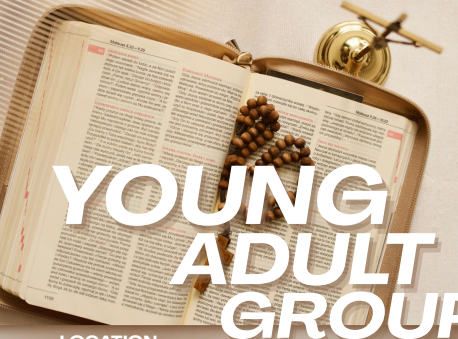

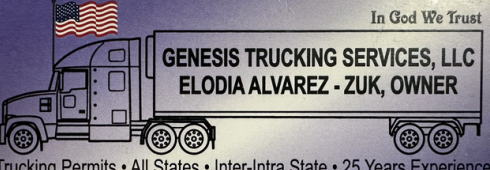

Remembering 9/11, 25 years later: 'We are never alone'

Twenty-five years after the terrorist attacks killed almost 3,000 people in New York, Pennsylvania, and Washington D.C., Archbishop Ronald Hicks of New York recalls the faith that helped people through that day, highlights the memorials to mark the anniversary, and stresses that even in “our tragedies...we are never alone.” By Kielce Gussie “Everyone I’ve talked to remembers exactly where they were 25 years ago,” says Archbishop Ronald Hicks of New York, referring to the anniversary marking a quarter of a century since the attacks of September 11, 2001. Whether you were working, in school, or not yet born, the events of that day changed aspects of the world. For Archbishop Hicks, September 11, 2001 started in the classroom during his graduate studies as a priest in the Archdiocese of Chicago, Illinois. From The *Pastor*

“Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive?” Matthew 18:21-35

Dear Brothers and Sisters: Grace and peace from our Lord Jesus Christ. In today’s Gospel the Lord answers the question of Peter presented to you in this article. How many times have we reflected on this essential topic of our Christian life? Mother Teresa has said if we cannot forgive, we cannot live. There is a poignant environment of hostility and hatred around the world—even among us. This may only be my impression, but I can see the results of this nonsense. May I be the first one to ask for forgiveness. However, I think that there is a need for true forgiveness; Jesus invites us to do it from the heart!

Unconditional Gift: True forgiveness mirrors Jesus offering bread to Judas at the Last Supper; it does not wait for contrition or apology. Forgiving someone does not mean pretending the pain or evil did not happen. Instead, it ensures that resentment does not control or dictate the future.

Liberation of the Giver: Even if the other person rejects the gesture or the forgiveness seems in vain, the act itself frees the giver from the solitary confinement of bitterness and restores inner peace.

Let us ask ourselves how we can be bridges of reconciliation and peace instead of promoting heart attacks and resentment wherever we are. LET US BE HEALING PEOPLE IN DIFICULT TIMES! It has been said that ‘the church is not a museum for saints but is a hospital for sinners.’ It’s possible that this phrase has its spiritual foundation in Matthew 9:11-12 which reads, “Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick.” However, some attribute this quote to some of the fathers of the Church like St. Augustine of Hippo or St. John Chrysostom. Regardless of its origin, we need to face ourselves in the mirror of truth and ask ourselves to whom will we respond? Are we going to respond to Our Lord in this invitation to forgive and to live our Christian life in a deeper way? We ask for forgiveness for the times our lives have not corresponded to what we preach or teach. But in the end, this will have to be a personal response we must answer in the presence of God.

“I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to” Matthew 18:32. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant? Let us not forget how merciful the Lord has been to us and let us treat others with the same mercy.

“Señor, si mi hermano peca contra mí, ¿cuántas veces debo perdonarlo?” Mateo 18:21-35

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas: Gracia y paz de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. En el Evangelio de hoy, el Señor responde a la pregunta de Pedro que se les presenta en este artículo. ¿Cuántas veces hemos reflexionado sobre este tema esencial de nuestra vida cristiana? La Madre Teresa ha dicho que si no podemos perdonar, no podemos vivir. Existe un ambiente conmovedor de hostilidad y odio alrededor del mundo, incluso entre nosotros. Tal vez sea solo mi impresión, pero puedo ver los resultados de este sinsentido. Permítanme ser el primero en pedir perdón. Sin embargo, creo que existe la necesidad de un verdadero perdón; ¡Jesús nos invita a hacerlo desde el corazón!

Don Incondicional: El verdadero perdón refleja a Jesús ofreciendo pan a Judas en la Última Cena; no espera arrepentimiento ni disculpas. Perdonar a alguien no significa fingir que el dolor o el mal no ocurrieron. Más bien, asegura que el resentimiento no controle ni dicte el futuro.

Liberación de Quien Perdona: Incluso si la otra persona rechaza el gesto o el perdón parece en vano, el acto mismo libera a quien perdona del confinamiento solitario de la amargura y restaura la paz interior.

Preguntémonos cómo podemos ser puentes de reconciliación y paz en lugar de promover ataques al corazón y resentimiento dondequiera que estemos. ¡SEAMOS PERSONAS QUE SANAN EN TIEMPOS DIFÍCILES! Se ha dicho que “la Iglesia no es un museo para santos, sino un hospital para pecadores”. Es posible que esta frase tenga su fundamento espiritual en Mateo 9:11-12, que dice: “Los sanos no tienen necesidad de médico, sino los enfermos”. Sin embargo, algunos atribuyen esta cita a algunos de los Padres de la Iglesia como San Agustín de Hipona o San Juan Crisóstomo. Independientemente de su origen, necesitamos enfrentarnos al espejo de la verdad y preguntarnos a quién vamos a responder. ¿Vamos a responder a Nuestro Señor en esta invitación a perdonar y a vivir nuestra vida cristiana de una manera más profunda? Pedimos perdón por las veces en que nuestras vidas no han correspondido a lo que predicamos o enseñamos. Pero al final, esta será una respuesta personal que debemos dar en la presencia de Dios.

“Te perdoné toda tu deuda porque me lo suplicaste” Mateo 18:32. ¿No debías tú también haber tenido compasión de tu compañero? No olvidemos cuán misericordioso ha sido el Señor con nosotros y tratemos a los demás con la misma misericordia.

Saint of the Day / Santo del dia

s. Miguel, arcángel

"Y luego que estábamos un poco más lejos,oí gritar: "María, ora por nosotros. Oí gritar 'Miguel' y 'Pedro', y 'todos los santos'."(Purgatorio XIII, 49-51). Estos son algunos versos del Canto XIII del Purgatorio de Dante. El Poeta deambula muy conmovido entre las almas de los envidiosos, mientras que la atmósfera del círculo en el que se desarrolla la escena es atravesada por voces misteriosas que recuerdan ejemplos de caridad. Incluso desde las atormentadas sombras, apiladas contra la roca que sufren con los párpados cosidos, se levantan las letanías. Imploran la intercesión de la Virgen e inmediatamente después de ella, y antes de Pedro y todos los Santos, invocan el nombre de "Miguel". Cuando Dante citaba al Arcángel en el verso 51, en el canto anterior el autor de la Divina Comedia acababa de ver caer "del cielo como un rayo" al otro ángel, definido como "noble creado más que otra creatura".



La espada de la Palabra de Dios contra el mal
Miguel y Lucifer. También en la Divina Comedia hay un espacio para describir el duelo mortal entre aquel que la biblia llama "comandante supremo del ejército celestial" y el jefe de los ángeles rebeldes que decidieron prescindir de Dios y fueron alejados de su presencia para siempre. Según la tradición, el Arcángel Miguel es el Príncipe que lucha contra el mal, de cuyos asaltos defiende perpetuamente la fe y la Iglesia. (Cf Apocalipsis 12,7-8). Incluso Dante, en 1200, muestra cómo se reconoce el poder de intercesión atribuido a esta entidad espiritual, muy venerada tanto en Oriente como en Occidente.**Leer artículo completo en: <https://www.vaticannews.va/es/santos/09/29/s--miguel--arcangel.html>**

St. Michael, Archangel

And when we pass'd a little forth, I heard
A crying, "Blessed Mary! pray for us,
Michael and Peter! all ye saintly host!"
(Dante, Purgatory, Canto XII, 51)
As he passes among the souls of the envious Purgatory, the great Christian poet Dante hears mysterious voices recalling examples of charity – the opposite of envy. Even among the suffering souls, whose eyes are sewn shut, litanies arise. They implore the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and immediately afterward – and before Peter and all the Saints – the name of “Michael.” In the previous canto, Dante had already seen the image of St Michael's great antagonist, Lucifer, the “most noble” of the angels, who fell from heaven like lightning.
The sword against evil

Even in the Divine Comedy we see the comparison between Michael, described in the Bible as the head of the heavenly armies; and the leader of the angels who rose up against God, and were cast into Hell. St Michael is the Prince of Heavenly Hosts who fights against evil, defending the Church and the Faith against the assaults of Satan. And even Dante, in the 13th century, recognized the power of the intercession of St Michael, who is venerated in both East and West.
“Who is like unto God?”

One can hardly count the number of cathedrals, shrines, monasteries, chapels - but also mountains, caves and hills – named for St Michael the Archangel.
